Pursuant to section 307(b)(1) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1) (2006 & Supp. V 2011), Rule 15 of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, and Rule 15 of the Local Rules of this Court, the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers, Iron Ship Builders, Blacksmiths, Forgers & Helpers, AFL-CIO hereby petitions this Court for review of the United States Environmental Protection Agency Administrator’s final rule entitled “Standards of Performance for Greenhouse Gas Emissions from New, Modified, and Reconstructed Stationary Sources: Electric Utility Generating Units.” The aforementioned rule was made final for purposes of judicial review by publication in the *Federal Register* at 80 Fed. Reg. 64,510 (Oct. 23, 2015).

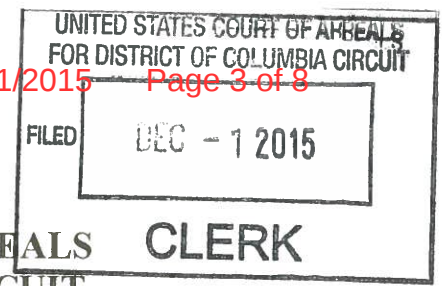

5. IBB is affiliated with the American Federation of Labor-Congress of Industrial Organizations (AFL-CIO).
6. IBB and its affiliated lodges own approximately 60 percent of the outstanding stock of Brotherhood Bancshares, Inc., the holding company of the Bank of Labor. Bank of Labor's mission is to serve the banking and other financial needs of the North American labor movement.
7. No entity owns 10 percent or more of IBB.

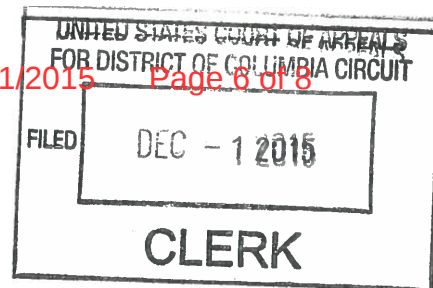
