**ORDER**

Upon consideration of petitioner Truck Trailer Manufacturers Association, Inc.'s motion to stay the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration Rules relating to trailers, the oppositions thereto, and the reply; and the Rule 28(j) letter, and the response thereto, it is,

**ORDERED** that to the extent they apply to truck trailers, the compliance dates for NHTSA fuel economy regulations be stayed pending further order of the court. Petitioner has satisfied the stringent requirements for a stay pending court review. See Nken v. Holder, 556 U.S. 418, 434 (2009); D.C. Circuit Handbook of Practice and Internal Procedures 33 (2019).
